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| <p><b>Appointment 1: Consultation</b></p> <p>This is the introductory appointment for the patient. | <p><b>Appointment 2: Start Up</b></p> <p>Also known as the “records appointment”, this is where we collect all the information needed by the lab to start the case. | <p><b>Appointment 3: Surgery</b></p> <p>The day of surgery. The patient will typically be sedated at the beginning of the appointment. All their teeth will be extracted, bone grafting placed, followed by implants and immediate restorations. | <p><b>Appointment 4: Post-Op</b></p> <p>This is a short post-operative visit. | <p><b>Appointment 5: Scanning for 2nd Set of Temps</b></p> <p>This appointment occurs after the implants have healed. Typically, around 3 - 4 months after surgery. | <p><b>Appointment 6: Delivery of Temps &amp; Scanning for Finals</b></p> <p>The second set of temps will be delivered, and any adjustments made to prepare them for finals. Scans will be taken and final zirconia bridges ordered.</p>                                                                            | 3 on 6 Temporary Restoration Upper (cc), 3 on 6 Temporary Restoration Lower (cc), Intraoral scan (cc)                                                                                |
| <p><b>Appointment 7: Delivery of Final Zirconia</b></p> <p>This is the patient’s final big appointment. The second set of temps will be removed and finals will be seated. | <p><b>Appointment 8: Follow-Ups</b></p> <p>We recommend the patient come in for a follow-up within a couple weeks after receiving their finals.
